



Mr. Casey's Celebrated Failure

Every enterprise, that endures for sufficient time, and earns the interest of millions, acquires a "literature." Baseball has its literature—and it has had quite a number of songs, most popular of which were "Slide, Kelly, Slide" and "Take Me Out to the Ball Game." The former popped up in the late eighties, and gained a wide vogue. It's theme was the remarkable sliding ability of Michael J. Kelly, known to a generation of fans as "King Kelly." The ditty extolled the virtues of his famous hook slide, which won many a ball game for his team. The request to take me out to the ball game came along about 1900. It still is radioed, occasionally, and nearly always played at baseball gatherings of especial moment.

But the literature of baseball rests upon Ernest L. Thayer's immortal poem, "Casey at the Bat." Ever since it first saw the light of type (in the San Francisco Examiner June 3, 1888) the verses have been known to each succeeding generation. DeWolf Hopper used it as a recitation, in the way of a curtain call, or by special request, some 14,000 times in a stage career of many, many years. The original of "Casey" was John P. P. Cahill, who played ball on the Pacific Coast in the '80's. The poem was first recited by Hopper at Wallack's Theater, New York, in the fall of 1888, in the course of a presentation of "Prince Methuselah."


